Provides access to Top Level Navigational items and associated mega-menus for quick access/deep linking. Supports breadcrumb navigational element.


4 Stock Ticker



The tile metaphor is effective because it showcases bits of information that are most practical and beneficial to the user. Information that is task driven for example, gives the user an opportunity to be more efficient with their tasks and responsibilities.

The DWP Home page will support customizable Tiles that are displayed with a Rail System Grid.

Tiles can appear in three different sizes. (1) 1x1 - Square, (2) 1x2 - Wide, (3) 1x2 - Tall. Larger tile sizes will span across the Rail system.


The DWP Home page will support users/viewers ability to customize the layout and arrangement of the tiles, by selecting the Edit option within the global banner menu.

Tiles are intended to display most recent content from a number of content providers. Their behavior allow users to customize news feeds from various sources, and sites, and allow quick access to most relevant materials or tasks.

2.3 Global Tile Layout Specification

1 Display Order & Reordering

With the exception of the customizable 'My Workplace' Homepage-Tiles display in a first in, first out order: from left top right, top to bottom in the desktop experience.

Once the tile selections have been saved and the Tile Gallery has been closed, the system will update the homepage UI with newly selected tiles at the bottom right.

Added tiles to be positioned to fit in the most appropriate available space based on the size of the tile up until the left.

If tile row is full a new pinned tile positions to the row below it.

No blank or empty space to the left of any pinned tile.

If a user is attempting to pin a double wide tile to a FOURTH column of a row space then system pins the tile to the next row leaving the single wide slot open in the fourth column.

If a one third height tile is selected for a single wide tile space the tile positions itself at the top.

If a half height tile is selected for a single wide tile space the tile positions itself at the top.


Any subsequent 3rd height and 1/2 height tiles go to the empty slots.

When the tile is removed the remaining tiles shift to the left covering empty spaces.


The number of rows for pinning of tiles is unlimited.

A Tile Label

A label appearing in the upper left hand corner that describes the nature of the tile content. styles below are the default:





There are three basic tile shapes, and various layouts for each. Tiles have a fixed height of 342px (A&B), or 165 (C), or 106 (D).



A Standard Shape

Can contain any content. Images usable but not required.

B Double-Wide Shape

Preferred presentation for media-rich content (video, photo galleries, etc.)

Double-Wide tile requires use of image.

Default for Featured News

This tile size rescales to the standard width for mobile, truncating content where necessary.

C 1/2 Tile Shape

1/2-Tile shape is only dedicated to quicklink tiles.

D 1/3 Tile Shape

1/3-Tile shape is only dedicated to quicklink tiles.






1 Tile Gallery Link

On DWP Home Page, click the "Tile Gallery" link on the global left menu. Alternatively the last tile on the bottom right of your home page will be a persistent tile that also grants access to the tile gallery.







1 Global Search Result

Global Search Result uses a variation of the List View Template for mobile. Search results are broken up by category (SBG, News, Directory, etc.). Maximum number of search results shown are 3, with an option to see "More" which will bring the user to a separate page with full listing of search results. Navigating back from this list will return the user to the categorized global search result.

2 List View Image

List view on mobile can support images. Images are contained within circles 32x32px in dimension. Padding is 12px from the left of the image.

3 List View CTA

List view on mobile supports up to one CTA button within the list itself. CTA buttons within lists are contained within a square 50x50px bounding box, flush right with the list column. CTA buttons may have multiple states, both Active and Inactive states.

4 List View


List view can be shown with or without actionable CTA buttons. List is vertically scrollable and navigation back is accessed via back button breadcrumb at the top.

5 List View: Scrolled with Pagination

Scrolling with pagination is not the recommended method of list view, but may be applicable in some circumstances within the DWP. List with pagination would have a maximum of 100 list results on a single page. Pagination appears when scrolled to the bottom of the available list items.

6 Mobile Content Scroll Interaction

Building off systems defined on desktop, mobile "breadcrumb" back navigation persists while scrolling. Container is 40px in height. Drop shadow is #000000, 15% opacity, 3px Y Offset, 3px Blur.
